USMS has introduced a new **Club Development Grant Program** to help clubs expand their capacity at current and/or new facilities.

Who is eligible?

- USMS clubs interested in growth.
- · Aquatics facilities with a plan to start a USMS club.
- Coaches interested in starting a new USMS club at an identified facility.
- USA Swimming clubs.
- Unrenewed or lapsed USMS clubs.

At this point, this program is flexible and USMS would entertain various scenarios for building Masters Swimming programs that are projected to become financial viable and sustainable within the first six months of operation.
